Reason

French airworthiness requirements do not allow lead cushions or sandbags in the cockpit to exeed

the minimum cockpit payload.

Therefore, detachable trim weights must be installed. The weights in front of the pedals cannot be reached

too easy but they may not injure the pilot in emergency landings. On the other hand a noticeable change of trim is possible with a minimum of

additional weight.
