Increase of the mass of the non lift producing

parts by 10 kg

Affected gliders:

All ASW 22s.

Compliance:

None; optional.

Reason:

For long distance flights, e.g. in the Alps, a complete emergency kit may be desirable in addition to the oxygen system; the normal useful load

would not be sufficient in this case.

Action:

1. Oxygen system and emergency kit must be fitted according to the manufacturer's instructions and the notes in the ASW 22 Flight and Maintenance Manual respectively.

2. Supplemental substantiation (7 pages) has been established for this Technical Note and demonstrates that no structural modification is necessary.

In the ASW 22 Flight Manual the pages 15 and 19 and in the Maintenance Manual the pages 8, 32, and 33 must be exchanged for pages with the same numbers showing the correction entry "only for T.N. no.3"; the exchanged pages must be listed in the "Index Of Corrections" (pages 1 + 2).

After the installation of oxygen system and emergency kit a mass and C.G. weighing procedure must

be done.

This T.N. no.3 must be accomplished only by SCHLEICHER or by a specified technical aviation

station.
