As the fatigue tests did not cover the entire (fiber composite) glider, the service life of 12000 hours can be granted only if the airworthiness of each individual glider (beyond the obligatory annual C. of A. inspections) is demonstrated in a special multi-step inspection program for the purpose of increasing the service life.			
Action:	The Maintenance Manual pages 1, 6, 60 and 61 must be exchanged for pages with the revi- sion entry & date "TN 13 / 15.01.2002 Juw" and the new page 76 must be inserted. The Re- pair Manual must be exchanged for the amended issue from April 1999. The Maintenance Instructions and other papers that are stated on the amended page 76, including this Tech- nical Note itself, must be inserted into the Appendix of the Maintenance Manual. The instructions and notes given in the amended manual pages must be regarded! The accomplishment of the change to the Manual must be documented on the respective Page "Index of Corrections" in the Maintenance Manual.			
	For Manual amendments please regard the following information : When an existing Manual page which should be exchanged against a new one according to this TN is already an amended one because of an earlier TN, both pages remain in the Manual.
